## **Curriculum Content Objectives**

To receive credit, students will perform each of the following content objectives:

1. Explain drawing scale
2. Examine residential working drawings
  - Floor plans
  - Sections
  - Elevation
  - Site Plan
3. Identify architectural drawings/symbols
4. Interpret working dimensions
5. Demonstrate knowledge of 5 to 6 national/state/local residential building codes

## **Assessments**

Students must achieve no less than 80% or B for a final grade in the high school course to receive ACC.

## **ACC Concept**
