2. Prepare, install or demonstrate doors and windows
3. Identify exterior finishes
4. Prepare and install exterior finishes

  - Flashing
  - Housewrap
  - Soffits
  - Siding accessories/siding

## **Assessments**

Students must achieve no less than 80% or B for a final grade in the high school course to receive ACC.

Students will need to register for the college class but at a lowered tuition rate.
