Articulated College Credit Plan *for* **Servsafe Certification**

Course:

CULN1210 – Servsafe Certification - 1 credit

This articulated college credit is only available to students in high schools that are part of a current articulation agreement.

The Concept:

Skills and content for selected introductory course(s), required at St. Cloud Technical & Community College, are taught in participating schools using the assessments agreed upon by secondary and post secondary staff. This agreement is developed to lessen content duplication and promote a more seamless transition from secondary to post-secondary education. High School and college credits are earned if the student meets the college achievement standards and later enrolls in a college major that requires the course or courses. In some cases, credit toward electives is also an option.

Course Description:

This manager level course provides a working knowledge of safe food handling, personal hygiene, food-borne illnesses, HACCP procedures. This course is designed to prepare students for the State of MN Food Management Certificate Examination.

Course Outcomes:

1. Identify and understand food-borne illnesses.
2. Understand proper sanitation techniques.
3. Practice good personal hygiene methods.
4. Successfully pass all state food safety tests.

NOTE:

To High school teacher: this is either Food Handler or Food Manager Certificate to get 1 credit and students must pass all tool, and Minnesota State safety tests along with demonstration and testing done in a fully equipped kitchen. Students will still be required to attend SCTCC course but will receive 1 credit. (Updated 10/7/22)

To articulate this credit, a minimum of eight hours of instruction must occur in an equipped kitchen as well as successfully passing the State of MN Food Management Certificate Examination.
