These credits are valid for students 2 years after high school graduation from the completion of this course.

Curriculum Content Objectives:

100% of the curriculum learning outcomes will be covered in the high school course(s) by qualified CTE high school instructor(s).

These credits are designed for high school students to earn 3 full elective credits in the Agriculture program. High School curriculum areas that may be eligible to articulate are agriculture courses such as:

1. Animal Science II
2. Farm Business Management
3. Crop Science

Assessments:

Students must achieve no less than 80% or B for a final grade in the high school course to receive ACC.

3. Complete hands on final exam
